Motion was made by Council Member DeLeon, seconded by Council Member Gilbreath to pass on first reading Ordinance No. 2005-00108 as recommended by staff. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 0 Nays.

(2.) **Resolution No. 2005-R0405 expressing financial and other support by the City of Lubbock for the George W. Bush Library.**

Jeff Yates, Director of Fiscal Policy and Strategic Planning gave comments and answered questions from Council.

Motion was made by Council Member Gilbreath, seconded by Council Member Boren to pass Resolution No. 2005-R0405 as recommended by staff. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 2 Nays. Mayor McDougal and Mayor Pro Tem Martin voted Nay.

(3.) **Resolution No. 2005-R0406 expressing the support of the City of Lubbock to change the names of all or a portion of the two streets intersecting the George W. Bush Library to Laura Bush Lane and George W. Bush Parkway.**

Motion was made by Council Member Gilbreath, seconded by Council Member Jones to pass Resolution No. 2005-R0406 as recommended by staff. Motion carried: 6 Yeas, 1 Nay. Council Member DeLeon voted Nay.

Motion was made by Council Member Price, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Martin to reconsidered this item. Motion carried: 7 Yeas, 0 Nays.

Council Member Price commented against changing the names of two streets due to the impact it would have on the business owners and the current layout of the City's streets should not be changed.

Motion was made by Council Member Gilbreath, seconded by Council Member Boren to pass Resolution No. 2005-R0406 as recommended by staff. Motion carried: 5 Yeas, 2 Nays. Council Members DeLeon and Price voted Nay.
