The City Council of the City of Lubbock, Texas met in special session on the 17th day of May, 2007, in the City Council Chambers, first floor, City Hall, 1625 13th Street, Lubbock, Texas at 2:00 P. M.

1. PROCLAMATIONS AND PRESENTATIONS

1.1. Invocation by City Councilman Floyd Price.

Pledge of Allegiance was given in unison by those in the City Council Chambers to both the United States flag and the Texas flag.

2. REGULAR AGENDA

2.1. Election Resolution - City Secretary: Resolution No. 2007-R0196 to canvass the vote and declare the results of the May 12, 2007, City of Lubbock Special Election for District 3 Council Member, and calling a Runoff Election.

The governing body is required to canvass election results not earlier than the third day or later than the eleventh day after Election Day. Each Council Member will be provided with tabulation sheets showing the total number of votes cast for each candidate, and the number of votes cast for each candidate by precinct. The resolution will canvass the returns and declare the results of the Special Election for the City Council Member for District 3. If no candidate for this position receives more than 50 percent of the votes cast for that office, a runoff election is required for that office.

FISCAL IMPACT

No fiscal impact anticipated.

The City Secretary recommended that the City Council accept the returns and act favorably on the resolution, and that a runoff election be called if no

candidate for this office receives more than 50 percent of the votes cast for that office.

Rebecca Garza, City Secretary, read the votes received for the election. No candidate received more than 50 percent of the votes cast for that office; therefore, Garza recommended that a runoff election be called.

Motion was made by Council Member DeLeon, seconded by Council Member Leonard to pass Resolution No. 2007-R0196 as recommended by staff. Motion carried: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays.
