1. REGULAR AGENDA

- 1.1. Election Resolution - City Secretary: Resolution No. 2010-R0233 to canvass the vote and declare the results of the May 8, 2010, City of Lubbock General Election and calling a Runoff Election if necessary.**

Rebecca Garza, City Secretary, read the results received from the 2010 General Election. Tom Martin received the majority vote for the Mayor's race. For District 3, Todd R. Klein ran unopposed; therefore he was declared elected. Karen Gibson received the majority vote for District 5. For Council Member District 1, no candidate received more than 50 percent of the votes cast for that office. Ms. Garza recommended to the Council to accept these results and call a runoff election on June 12, 2010, for District 1 candidates Victor Hernandez and Glen Robertson.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Gilbreath, seconded by Council Member Leonard, to approve Resolution No. 2010-R0233. Motion carried: 7 Ayes, 0 Nays.

Council Member, District 5 – Mayor Martin presented Ms. Gibson with a certificate that certified her election. Karen Gibson was sworn in by Jerry Ramirez. Karen gave thanks to the support of citizens, campaign workers, family, and friends.
