1. REGULAR AGENDA

This was an event in which a quorum of City Council Members attended and participated in a dedication ceremony for veterans' headstones.

1.1 Dedication Ceremony for Veterans' Headstones- This ceremony was to dedicate the settings of Veterans' Administration headstones at the graves of veterans who were buried by Lubbock County and who did not have a headstone and for whom no family could be found. The ceremony is also to dedicate the effort to provide these headstones for the veterans.

Rod Manning, Chaplain Disabled American Veterans Post 44, welcomed those in attendance and led the invocation. Carl Knott, Mayor Tom Martin, and Council Member Paul R. Beane gave comments, and Council Member Beane recognized the Veterans in attendance. He also recognized Sylvia Chapa for her efforts in obtaining the tombstones for the graves of the veterans. Shirley Bland, American Legion Post 575, gave the honorary roll call of Lubbock County General Assistance Veteran Interments. The ceremony continued with the laying of the Commemorative Wreath, followed by the Rifle Salute, the presentation of the flag to Carl Knott, and the Retiring of Colors. Benediction was led by Mr. Manning.
