2) Citizen Comments

This period, of up to thirty minutes, is dedicated to citizen comments. Each citizen will have three minutes to speak. All comments must be limited to only those items posted on the Annexation and Growth Advisory Committee Agenda. Any citizen wishing to speak shall sign up on the citizen comment sheet on the day of the Committee Meeting. The Committee shall follow the order of citizens wishing to speak as listed on the sign-up sheet. If everyone who signed up to speak has been given an opportunity to speak and the thirty minutes designated for citizen comment has not been exhausted, the Chairman of the Committee has the discretion to open the floor to anyone else wishing to address the Committee, subject to all the same procedures and guidelines. The Chairman of the Committee has the discretion to appoint a representative to speak on behalf of a group of citizens from a particular neighborhood or area if it appears that another citizen, or group of citizens, will not have the opportunity to speak during the thirty minute period. If a citizen wishes to produce a written statement instead of speaking, the citizen must sign up on the citizen comment sheet and deliver the written statement to the Chairman to be read during the citizen comment portion of the meeting, with such written statement subject to the same procedures and guidelines as all spoken comments.
