2016-17 HUNTING SEASON INSTRUCTIONS, LAHWMA

Hunters **MUST** submit a copy of their driver's license, hunting license and fill out and sign a liability release before purchasing a Permit, and report **ALL** harvest information. **All hunters born after 9-2-1971 must have proof of a Hunter Education Training Course Certificate on their person while hunting; or possess a HE Deferral. Purchase of a permit does NOT guarantee the harvest of game.**

DOVE & QUAIL HUNTS

Hunters may purchase permits for the above dates on a "first-come, first-served" basis. Permits MUST be purchased by WEDNESDAY 3pm before the weekend that you plan to hunt. Hunters must bring their driver's license (DL) to indicate residency, 2016-17 hunting license (HL) complete with stamps (migratory game bird stamp and HIP certificate are required to hunt any legal dove, upland game bird stamp required for quail) and cash, check or MasterCard/Visa in order to obtain a permit and reserve space. **Hunters purchasing by fax must include copies of their DL and HL with their application.** There will be no refund for permits not subsequently used, and no date substitution due to adverse weather conditions. Quail and dove bag and possession limits conform to those established by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department for Kent and Garza County. Absolutely NO baiting will be allowed before or during dove hunts.

DEER HUNTS – ARCHERY AND RIFLE (NOTE: any harvested male deer -even an unbranched antlered buck- counts against your buck tag total)

Deer hunters may be included in a RANDOM DRAWING for the available hunts as shown. An archery stamp on your HL is required to bow hunt. Hunting parties must sign up together; specify deer hunt of your selection - only one entry per person or hunting party, per hunt. Antlerless mule deer harvest is illegal.

Drawing for the archery hunts will take place on September 12th; winners will be notified by email. Archery permits must be purchased by September 19th to reserve your space. Cancellations after Sept. 23rd will result in loss of any paid fees. Archery hunters who have purchased a WT unbranched antlered buck/WT antlerless/turkey archery permit (Oct. 21-23) may harvest no more than two (2) WT antlerless, AND one WT unbranched antlered, AND one either-sex Rio Grande turkey AND unlimited feral hog. These permits will be drawn on October 3rd and must be purchased by Oct. 10th to reserve your space. Cancellation after Oct. 17th will result in loss of fees. Participants for this hunt must have an archery stamp and an upland game bird stamp for turkey on their hunting license. *(This hunt may be subject to cancellation if no more than 5 people sign up.)*

Drawing for the rifle hunts begin on October 17th, with WT Buck and WT Antlerless draws. WT antlered hunters may take no more than one (1) WT antlered. WT antlerless hunters may take no more than (two) 2 WT antlerless per hunter, and unlimited feral hog during any deer hunt. There will be no refund of permits not subsequently used, and no date substitutions due to adverse weather conditions. Mule deer antlered rifle hunt will be drawn on November 7th; hunters may take no more than one (1) antlered mule deer, and unlimited feral hog. Hunters use their own tree stand or blind, and bring bait of their selection. Hunters must remove blinds/stands from City property immediately after their hunt is ended. NO BATTERY POWERED FEEDERS OR ROAD BAITING ALLOWED.

TURKEY HUNTS 2017

Spring gobbler (or bearded hen) turkey hunts are available by RANDOM DRAWING. Hunting parties must sign up together; specify the hunt date of your choice – only ONE entry per person or hunting party, per hunt. **Drawing for the turkey hunts will take place on March 20th.** Spring turkey hunters may take one (1) turkey per hunter, and unlimited feral hog. Permits must be purchased by March 27th to reserve your space. Cancellation after April 3rd will result in the loss of any paid fees. There will be no refund of permits not subsequently used, and no date substitutions due to adverse weather conditions. Turkey hunters may be assigned a specific area in which to hunt. An upland game bird stamp on your hunting license is required to hunt turkeys.

FERAL HOG HUNTS 2017

Permits MUST be purchased by Wednesday 3 pm before the weekend that you plan to hunt; hunters may be assigned to specific hunt areas.
