WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 89 requires all Texas cities to adopt an annexation plan on or before December 31, 1999, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lubbock has no current plans to annex any area for which an annexation plan is required; NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LUBBOCK:

THAT the City of Lubbock does not currently plan to annex any area for which an annexation plan is required.


